The Squash Club in Salzburg is looking for a new Head Coach. The club hast 4 Squashcourts and 7 Tenniscourts. The Website is <a href="https://www.tenniscourt.at">www.tenniscourt.at</a>

Every year the club hosts1 national Junior tournament, where about 70 kids participate and one PSA tournament. Besides, the club plays in the first Austrian Squash League. So this place would also suit very well for a player who wants to train and play tournaments. The Austrian number 1 Aqeel Rehman is based at this club, and it's only a one hour drive away to places in Germany to train with other good players.

Apart from our club there are 3 more squash clubs in the area, with quite a potential of coaching lessons, and already existing (small) junior groups. These clubs do need a coach, too. So, ideally one professional coach should cover those 3-4 clubs.

The biggest club, with the biggest potential is the Squash Club Salzburg though. We have a fairly big junior program running, with 25 kids at the moment, numbers still increasing. This is the most important part. At the moment there are 2 days of junior clinics each week, for 2 hours. It is the coach's decision to extend those. Some juniors are also up for private lessons.

For those junior clinics Martin Tollich will provide help, he has been working at the club for nearly 20 years. One of the kids at the Squash Club Salzburg is the number 2 - U19 girl of Austria, called Sabrina Rehman. Extra sessions with her are guaranteed; having a good coach for her is the second vital part,.

In addition to the junior clinics, all other coaching lessons are paid on top. There is potential to have 20-40 lessons a week, depending on the effort.

Every summer for 4 weeks there is a junior program run by the local government, which is paid reasonably well to, which provides a basic income during summer as well.

Junior clinics are usually rewarded with a fixed amount of money per month, negotiations can be made though. With a certain coaching qualification (either coaching course, or special experience for example former/active PSA player) there will be a funding from the government of around 1500€ per year and another 1500€ funding from the local county federation.

So there should be a low guaranteed salary of around 300-400€ per month, but all the rest is based on self effort and the number of private lessons held. Earning up to 2000€ per month is possible.

The club has friendly members and the persons in charge of the junior Club Rosmarie Rehman and Martin Tollich are happy to help to get settled and to provide any help needed.

The coach will also be able to provide services like racket restringing etc.

The job should start in September the latest.
